MEDICAL CARE COURSE (MEDICARE)

INTRODUCTION

This DG Shipping approved course aims at preparing those designated to take charge of medical care on board ship and aims to meet the mandatory minimum requirements for knowledge, understanding and proficiency in Section A-VI/4 paras 4 to 6 and Table A-VI/4-2 of the STCW 2010 as amended. This course is intended for candidates for certification as Chief Mates and Masters on sea going ships.

Through lectures, presentations, practical situations and demonstrations the participants are taught much beyond first aid. This course is conducted fully by a panel of highly qualified doctors.

IMO Model Course 1.15 is used in the preparation of the material for this course.

OBJECTIVE

On successful completion of this course, the seafarer shall be able to take charge of medical care on board ship. The level of knowledge acquired shall be sufficient to enable the seafarer to take immediate effective action in case of accident or illness likely to occur on board ship.
