INTRODUCTION

This DG Shipping approved course is a Mandatory requirement for Nautical Officers to serve on board ship and meets the requirements of IMO Model course 1.27 (Revised 2012). It meets the relevant requirements to ECDIS as laid down in Table A-II/1 (Operational Level), Table A-II/2 (Management Level) and Table A-II/3 of STCW Convention as amended in 2010.

OBJECTIVE

Those who successfully complete this course shall be able to demonstrate sufficient knowledge, skill and understanding of ECDIS Navigation and Electronic Charts to undertake the duties of a Navigational watch officer defined by STCW Code as amended.
