MEDICAL FIRST AID (MFA)

INTRODUCTION

This DG Shipping approved course aims at preparing seafarers to provide medical first aid in accordance with Reg. VI/4 para 1, Section A-VI/4 Para 1 to 3 and Table A-VI/4-1 of the STCW 2010 as amended.

In case there is any medical emergency in the middle of the ocean, life at sea can be scary since there are no doctors on a ship.

The medical first aid course equips the officer (both deck and engine) to handle any medical emergency on board a ship.

Through lectures, presentations, practical situations and demonstrations the participants are taught much beyond first aid. This course is conducted fully by a panel of highly qualified doctors

OBJECTIVE

The objectives of this course are to provide the student with the knowledge and skill in First Aid as well as equip them with information about medicines and procedures so as to be able to take immediate action in the case of accident or illness likely to occur on board ship.
