

CHIEF MATE (PHASE II)

INTRODUCTION

The MP-II Course, which is approved by the DG Shipping, prepares a student to successfully compete for the Certificate of Competency (COC) examination as Chief Mate of a Foreign Going Ship. The course meets the standards of competence required under STCW 2010; Regulation II/2 and specified in Section A-II/2.

OBJECTIVE

By strictly adhering to the syllabus and guidelines of the D.G. Shipping, Government of India, the course imparts knowledge, which goes beyond answering the question papers. The course further develops candidates to become world-class, senior management, officers who are confident in taking the responsibility as Chief Mate of a foreign going vessel.

Furthermore, the Course explains and imparts knowledge related to the new Conventions and regulations, as well as the latest developments in the Maritime Industry, which is also specific to themes of new developments in the maritime.

The course provides proficiency at Management Level in the following areas:

1. Navigational Aids including compass.
2. Bridge watch-keeping, ship-handling and Emergencies
3. Naval Architecture Paper II.
4. Maritime Legislation.
5. Orals for navigation & ship operation functions.

The written examination for this course is conducted by Mercantile Marine Department (MMD) at Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Kandla, Kochi and Kolkata. The Certificate of Competency is awarded only to those candidates who have successfully met the following requirements:

1. Sea Service requirements.
2. Passed written examinations for Phase I & II.
3. Completed all relevant STCW courses.
4. Passed orals for ALL THREE functions.

Candidates will need to book their examination seats at respective MMD as mentioned above.
